Jock Gill called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM.

- 1. There were no additions to the agenda.
- 2. The minutes of July, 2020 meeting were approved.
- 3. There was no public comment.
- 4. Old business: Jock brought up the question of enforcement. Discussion followed about the lack of appetite for enforcement of zoning regulations. Jock commented that the tone relies on persuasion. All agreed that specific instructions from the select board would inform how this commission should carry out its duties.
