**Home energy bills** – electricity and fuel for lights, appliances, and heating – can be a big financial burden. If you need assistance with high energy bills, **help is available!**

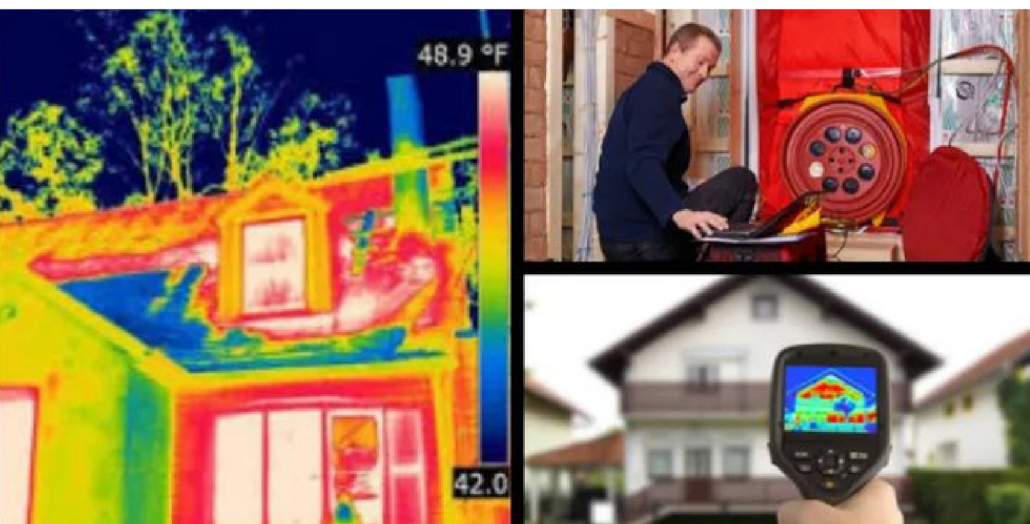


**FREE firewood** available at the Peacham Transfer Station. Delivery may be possible: 802-592-3076.
