Peacham Farm Support Fund

2023 Grant Application Guidelines

Background: In 2005, an anonymous donor established a permanent fund to support farming in Peacham. The Fund is private and is administered by the Vermont Community Foundation. The Town of Peacham is no longer directly involved with this Fund. A three-person committee (the Fund Committee) was established by the Vermont Community Foundation to make recommendations on how the Fund will be used. Ideas on how to use the Fund to support farming in Peacham are always welcome. Contact any member of the Fund Committee listed below or include ideas with your application. This year, income from the Fund is made available for small grants to farms of any kind (see definition below).

Application Procedure: To apply for a Peacham Farm Support Fund Grant, fill out the application below and sign where indicated. All farmers who reside in Peacham, who apply before the deadline, and who qualify as a farmer at the time of the distribution will be eligible. Applications must be returned to the town clerk, or mailed to the **Peacham Farm Support Fund, P.O. Box 244, Peacham, VT 05862**, by April 30, 2023. Grant awards will be made about a month later.

Available funding will be distributed to one or more qualifying farms. The money will be distributed to the qualifying farmers upon completion of the project.

The 2023 objective of the Fund is to **assist** with capital projects on farms in Peacham to make it more economically feasible to farm here. Projects could include energy efficiency, restoration of an active barn, permanent fencing, or any other project that you can demonstrate will make your operation more viable.
