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
- Most of these rides will take a recreational rider 2-3 hours
- The rides are primarily on hilly dirt/gravel roads...after all, this is Vermont!
- Wear a helmet and take plenty of water and maybe a snack
- Use the cue sheet (with mileage) and the map
- Enjoy what Vermont has to offer!

PEACHAM/MOSQUITOVILLE/RYEGATE CORNER BIKE RIDE

From Peacham Village (Town Hall/Post Office), head South by turning **Right** on Bayley Hazen Road (Main Street) to South Peacham

- 1.0 Mile Turn Left onto Peacham Barnet Road
- 1.7 Mile Turn Right up Aiken Farm Road
- 2.4 Mile Turn Right onto Harvey's Mountain Road
- 3.6 Mile Turn Right onto Mosquitoville Road
- 4.4 Mile Bear Left onto North Bayley Hazen Road
- 9.7 Mile arrive at Ryegate Corner, turn Right onto Witherspoon Rd (paved)
- ***Note: If you'd like a little side adventure you can go straight here for a beautiful view and a big hill, and visit Ticklenaked Pond, then come back and turn Left on Witherspoon at the Post Office. Adds 2.5 miles RT
- 12.8 Mile Turn Right on Hall Road
- 15.7 Mile Turn Right on Mosquitoville Road
- 17.5 Mile Turn Left on Mosquitoville Road
- 18.6 Mile Bear Right on Harvey's Mountain Road
- 19.7 Mile Turn Left on Aiken Farm Road
- 20.4 Mile Turn Left Peacham Barnet Road
- 21.1 Mile Turn Right on South Main Street (Bayley Hazen Road)
- 22.1 Mile arrive back at Peacham Village





PEACHAM/BARNET/RYEGATE/GROTON BIKE RIDE


From Peacham Village (Town Hall/Post Office) Head South by turning **Right** on Bayley Hazen Road (Main Street) to South Peacham

- 1.0 Mile Turn Left onto Peacham Barnet Road to stop sign in West Barnet
- **2.4 Mile** Turn **Right**, follow Harvey Mt Road along Harvey's Lake until you come to Mosquitoville Road
- 4.1 Mile Turn Right on Mosquitoville Road
- 5.1 Mile In Mosquitoville follow Mosquitoville Road to the right
- 7.0 Mile Turn Left onto Hall Road
- 8.0 Mile Turn Right onto Brock Road to the paved Peacham Groton Road
- 8.8 Mile Turn Left onto Peacham Groton Road sign says (Minard Hill Road however)
- **9.6 Mile** Turn **Right** onto Great Road-go a few miles, past Alpaca Farm...just past old schoolhouse on left (green house now)
- 14.2 Mile Turn Left onto County Road
- 14.6 Mile Bear Right onto Green Bay Loop until
- 17.9 Mile come to Maple Lane Here you can go either way back to Peacham Village (see map)

If you Turn Left on Maple Lane....
At 18.7 Mile, Turn Right on Mack's Mountain Rd
At 19.6 Mile you will be back at the village.

If you turn **Right** on Maple Lane... **At 18.5 Mile**. Turn **Left** on Main **At 19.2 Mile** you will be back at the village.






PEACHAM/DANVILLE BIKE RIDE

From Peacham Village (Town Hall /Post Office) head North by turning **Left** on the Bayley Hazen Road (Main Street) which turns into the Peacham Danville Road

- 2.7 Mile Turn Left onto Keiser Pond Road
- **6.5 Mile** in West Danville, ride through walking bridge, then turn **Right** onto the bike path (Rail Trail)
- **6.6 Mile** cross Rte 2, stay on bike path
- 7.4 Mile turn Left off bike path onto Kittredge Road
- 9.0 Mile turn Right onto Walden Hill Road
- 11.1 Mile arrive at Route 2, turn Left
- 11.2 Mile turn Right onto Park Street and cross the Danville Peacham Road
- 11.3 Mile turn Right onto Brainerd St
- 12.1 Mile bear Right onto dirt road which is Greenbanks Hollow Road
- 14.0 Mile go through covered bridge, turn Right on Brook Road
- 15.3 Mile go Straight across Peacham Danville Rd onto Harvey's Hollow Road
- 16.9 Mile turn Left onto Keiser Pond Rd
- 18.6 Mile turn Right onto Peacham Danville Rd
- 21.2 Mile arrive back at Peacham Village
- ***Alternate Route (more hills), at 14.0 Mile at bridge go Straight up Thaddeus Stevens Rd
- 15.9 Mile turn Left up Morrison Hill Rd
- 16.8 Mile turn Right on Somers Rd
- 17.8 Mile go Straight back onto Thaddeus Stevens Rd
- 18.3 Mile go Left at the triangle
- 19.1 Mile arrive in E. Peacham Village (mailboxes) go Straight onto Old Cemetery Rd
- 20.0 Mile arrive in Peacham Village




KEISER, EWELLS POND, JOE'S BROOK - DANVILLE /PEACHAM

From the Danville Green from Park Street, head down **Brainerd Street**, which becomes Greenbanks Hollow Road

- .85 Mile Bear Right off pavement up Greenbanks Hollow Road
- 2.69 Mile go through covered bridge then Right on Brook Road
- 3.98 Mile go Straight crossing Peacham Danville Road onto Harvey's Hollow Road
- 5.6 Mile turn Left onto Keiser Pond Road
- 7.2 Mile turn Right onto Peacham Danville Road
- 7.6 Mile turn Right onto Ewells Mill Road
- 8.1 Mile turn Right onto Bayley Hazen Road
- 8.4 Mile turn Left onto Slack Street
- 11.6 Mile turn Right onto Bayley Hazen Road (Danville Peacham Road)
- 11.8 Mile turn Left onto Willow Brook Road
- 12.4 Mile turn Left onto Old Cemetery Road
- 12.8 Mile turn Left onto East Peacham Road (pavement) behind the mailboxes
- 12.9 Mile turn Right onto Old County Road
- 15.0 Mile turn Right onto Danville Peacham Road
- *** (see Alternate Route for more miles on next page)
- 18.2 Mile Arrive back at the Danville Green

- ***Alternate Route for more miles, at 16.5 Mile turn Left on Oneida Road
- 19.7 Mile turn Right on Keiser Pond Road
- 20.5 Mile go through walking bridge in W. Danville, Right on Bike Path, crossing Rte 2
- 21.0 Mile turn Left off Bike Path onto Kittredge Hill Road
- 22.6 Mile turn Right onto Walden Hill Road
- 24.7 Mile turn Left on Route 2 to Danville Green
- 24.9 Danville Green






DANVILLE WATER ANDRIC RIDE

From the front of the Post Office (Danville Green) on Park Street, Bear **Right** down Brainerd Street

- .7 Mile you will cross the Rail Trail
- .85 Mile Bear Left on Pavement to Joe's Brook Road
- 3.5 Mile Turn Left onto Morses Mill Road
- 5.1 Mile Turn Left onto Keyser Hill Road
- **6.6 Mile** Take a **Sharp Left** onto Water Andric Road (There is a House right above where you turn.). Here is where you could also stay on Winn High Road to Trestle Road, avoiding Water Andric.
- ****The Water Andric may be washed out in places but you can walk your bike in there and lift it over the barriers to stay on the road which runs along the water. If you don't want to do this, do not take the sharp left onto Water Andric, keep going up Winn High Drive to Trestle Road. (See Map)
- 9.1 Mile Take a Right onto Trestle Road
- 10.2 Mile Intersect with Winn High Drive on your right, go Straight
- 10.7 Mile Take a Right onto Pumpkin Hill Road
- 11.6 Mile Take a Left onto Route 2B which is also Parker Road
- 13.9 Mile Cross Route 2, see sign for bike route onto Dole Hill Road
- 14.4 Mile Take a Right onto Cormier Road
- **16.8 Mile** Take a **Left** onto Bruce Badger Highway (North Danville Road)

 This turns into Hill Street in Danville Village
- 20.2 Mile Arrive back at Danville Green





NORTH DANVILLE LOOP

From the Danville Green, Head North onto Hill Street which turns into Bruce Badger Highway

- 3.7 Mile turn Left on McDowell Road
- **7.9 Mile** McDowell Road becomes Blakey Road (May have to walk bike after the cemetery through some rocks and runoff) but not for long
- 10.4 Mile turn Right on South Wheelock Road
- 13.0 Mile turn Right on Burroughs Road which turns into Wheelock Road
- 17.6 Mile turn Left on McDowell Road


Longer Ride: At 19.8 Mile turn Right on Coles Pond Road
20.8 Mile turn Left on Fellows Road
21.6 Mile turn Left on Morrill Road
23.0 Mile turn Right on Bruce Badger Highway

**This adds a couple of miles (26.5 to the Green), a long hill, but beautiful views at the top.

Shorter Ride: Just continue on McDowell Road without turning onto Coles Pond Road

- 20.4 Mile turn Right on Bruce Badger Highway
- **21.4 Mile** turn **Left** on Partridge Road (or can keep going straight to Danville Green here)
- **24.1 Mile** arrive at Danville Green






DANVILLE GREEN/WALDEN BIKE RIDE

From the Danville Green, Head West on Route 2 towards Montpelier

- .14 Mile Turn Right onto Walden Hill Road-stay on Walden Hill Road which eventually turns into Cobb Hill Road
- 5.6 Mile Turn Left onto Rock Road
- **5.8 Mile** Turn **Right** onto Noyestar Road. This road will go on for a while, may have to walk your bike up ahead for a little bit.
- 9.3 Mile Turn Left onto Keene Road
- **9.9 Mile** Turn **Left** onto Summerhill Road which bearing to the Left turns into Stevens Hill West, then Stevens Hill East Road
- 13.1 Mile You arrive at Walden Four Corners, turn Right onto Noyestar Road
- 15.4 Mile Turn Left up Maple Lane. (You have arrived at Rte 15)
- 16.7 Mile Turn Right onto Cobb Road, which will again turn into Walden Hill Rd
- **18.8 Mile** Arrive at Kittredge Hill Road.
- <u>Shorter Ride</u>: Keep straight on Walden Hill Road Back to Danville Village Total Miles: 21
- Longer Ride: Take a Right onto Kittredge Hill Road
- **20.5 Mile** Go **Right** onto the Rail Trail Bike Path, cross Route 2, ride through the covered Walk Bridge you will see ahead
- 21.4 Mile Take a Left onto Keiser Pond Road
- 21.7 Mile Take a Left onto Oneida Road to the end
- 25.0 Mile Take a Left onto the Peacham Danville Road
- 27.0 Mile Arrive back at the Danville Green





DANVILLE/BARNET/ST JOHNSBURY AND BIKE PATH RETURN

Start at the Old Railroad Station in Danville where you will get on the Rail Trail (Bike Path) in **back** of the Station headed East (to the **LEFT**) towards St Johnsbury

- .68 Mile turn RIGHT off the Bike Path on Brainerd Street
- .78 Mile Bear LEFT onto Joe's Brook Road
- 6.15 Mile turn Left onto Brook Hill Road
- 7.8 Mile turn Right onto Keyser Hill Road
- 9.3 Mile turn Right onto County Hill Road
- 10.9 Mile turn Left onto Route 5
- 11.1 Mile turn Right onto Bridge Street
- 11.3 Mile turn Left onto River Road (along the Passumpsic River)
- 14.7 Mile turn Left, going under the bridge
- **14.8 Mile** turn **Left** onto Bay Street
- **15.6 Mile** turn Left on Main Street and follow signs to the Rail Trail entrance which you will get on to go back to the Danville Railroad Station
- 26.2 Mile arrive back at the Station in Danville
